Staff Council Endorsement of Staff Leave Changes



Staff Council <u>unanimously endorsed</u> the proposed changes to the Staff Leave policy. However within our endorsement we shared the following concerns:

- With the exception of the Silver Circle, John Carroll University does not recognize long-term service to the University. If this policy were implemented, all exempt staff members would receive the same benefits regardless of tenure at the University. Staff Council believes that the recognition of length of service is an important part of talent retention.
- With the exception of the Silver Circle, prior service to the University is not considered as it relates to leave. Staff Council believes that prior service should be taken into account as it relates to how they accrue leave.
- If this policy were implemented, Staff Council is concerned how this might impact the morale of our non-exempt colleagues. Staff Council recognizes the difference in job functions and compensation, however it remains concerned about morale, especially in light of the restructuring.

- Spirit wear constitutes clothing that has John Carroll University or its approved logos (University Seal, Athletic Logo, University Logo) on it. Most JCU branded apparel for sale in the JCU Bookstore is appropriate. When in doubt, staff members are encouraged to consult with their supervisor.
- If the staff member has commitments in which spirit wear would not be appropriate (meetings, conferences, meetings with university constituents, etc.) they are encouraged to wear blue and gold while still meeting professional attire standards.
- Those participating in Blue Gold Days may wear JCU sweatshirts and fleeces, and are allowed to wear denim that would be considered "business casual" appropriate (i.e., not all jeans are created equal).
- Staff members are still expected to present a neat appearance and are not permitted to wear sweatpants or other athletic wear, leggings, tights, yoga pants or similarly inappropriate clothing.
- Staff members who are not participating must follow standard JCU dress guidelines.

The **Playhouse Square Corporate Exclusive Online** (CEO) Ticketing Program was designed to give you the exclusive convenience of purchasing your show tickets online at a special discount and often before the general public.

To order tickets for a show, enter the promotion code provided by your benefits administrator in the box above and follow the prompts through the purchase procedure. You will be sent a confirmation via e-mail with notification on where to pick up your tickets (based on the ticket pick-up method you selected). There is a small ticketing fee (only \$7 per order, not per ticket) and you often have the opportunity to buy tickets before the general public.
